



Private Event FAQ

How do I book an event? To book an event with us you need to contact our Private Events Director at catering@missouriwine.com or 573-698-3060 then sign a contract & pay the applicable rental fee.

What is your cancellation policy? The rental fee is non-refundable in the event of cancellation. You may reschedule without penalty with a minimum 2 week's notice.

Do you offer event coordination? Yes, our event director will assist with all planning aspects including: date/space selection, food & beverage selections, layout, vendor recommendations, and basic itineraries. The event director may not be present the day of your event. However, event coordinators are provided the day of to direct the event staff and work with the liaison from your party to make sure everything is to your expectations.

What are the responsibilities of the event staff? Our event staff will manage the indoor & outdoor layout, food & beverage service, and basic cleaning duties. They are not involved with decorating or entertainment.

What is your decorating policy? All decorations and vendor items are the client's responsibility to setup and must be removed at the conclusion of the event. No tacking or taping items to the walls or wood surfaces. No confetti, glitter, shredded material, birdseed, small beads, feathers, hay bales, or rice are permitted inside or outside. Throwing synthetic flower petals, flammable Chinese lantern releases, or balloon releases may not be done outside.

Do you offer any décor? Wine barrels can be rented for \$25/each.

What does the rental fee include? Rental fees for Bistro events include: tables/chairs, plates/utensils/glassware, white linens, bar setup & cake cutting service.

Are fireworks or sparklers allowed? Yes, sparklers are permitted with an applicable \$50 cleanup fee. Fireworks are allowed with proper licensing & insurance along with a \$100 cleanup fee.

Can I bring in my own food? All food & beverages are provided by Les Bourgeois for any events taking place at the Bistro with the exception of specialty desserts. At the A-Frame homemade snacks & non-alcoholic beverages are permitted.

When is final information & payment due? Final information is due two Mondays before the event. Payment is due at the conclusion of the event. Payments can certainly be made ahead of time.

Are pets allowed on property? Pets are allowed to partake in outdoor wedding ceremonies but must be removed from property afterwards.

What if it rains? Wedding ceremonies will take place inside the Terrace when inclement weather arises.
